The Kista incident

- Floor 3: Window frames and sashes were fixed last week with glass being replaced this week
- Floor 2: a bit more extensive work means it will take a couple of weeks before glass can be installed in the windows
- Added security continues and where windows are blocked with plywood we have installed portable volume alarms
- While Akademiska Hus is working on a temporary entrance, all visitors are referred to the entrance at Kistagången 16, which is the property's main entrance, or Isafjordsgatan 26
- Members of staff who are in need of support can contact their closest manager for further contact with the occupational health care provider, Avonova.

The University administration

Since the merging of the Professional support, we now go under the name University administration (UA) in English and Verksamhetsstödet (VS) in Swedish.





Financial statement 2022

- The total revenue compared to 2021 shows little change, 2%. However the basic education allocation is 10% lower.
- Main factors for that:
- 1. Fewer decisions on grants during the current year
- 2. Reduced appropriations linked to previous investment of government capital (SEK 10.2 million). This venture from 2015 is being phased out.
- 3. Lower examination allowance, as fewer doctoral students have defended their thesis during the pandemic (approximately SEK 4 million).

Financial statement 2022

- The total cost compared to 2021 shows little change, although an increase by 5% compared to 2021.
- Main factors for that:
 - The increased costs of premises are due to increased prices for electricity and cooling at PDC and the redevelopment of the cleanroom in the Electrum laboratory, a requirement.
 - 2. Travel is increasing and costs have been back to the prepandemic level since May (i.e. significantly higher than budgeted).
 - 3. From the end of 2021 until the beginning of 2023, PDC-HPC has invested in a new supercomputer (Dardel), including addons for the partner Scania. This is funded by the Swedish Research Council and Scania for five years (i.e. the entire depreciation period). Some investments have also been made i Kista, part of the increase. Depreciation will continue to increase, with an expected increase of 67% in 2023 (from SEK 40 million to SEK 67 million).

Financial statement 2022

Outcome

- The operating outcome for EECS 2022 was SEK -30.9 million.
- The negative result is covered by the authority capital of the school. From the aspect that the school has a high government capital, this year's use of MK is positive, but with expected increased costs in the coming years, which is due to the external situation with increased electricity and heating costs and a constantly increasing inflation, a coordination of planned investments in the VP and the increased costs is needed.
