

New organization 2026

- Suggest structure for organization by September 30, new organization should be in place by the new year 2026
- We will take away one level, and make our current division level our department level
 - We will start with 14 departments in the new organization
 - We aim to not have any departments with less than 70 MSek in turnover in a few years
 - Each department will have a support team of at least 1 ft economy, ½ ft management coordinator and
 ¼ HR
- Research and teaching will be managed on the same organizational level
 - Reducing the number of OH financed roles
- Prefect and Pro-prefect will together have between 50-80% depending on department size to lead the work
- Process to appoint prefects has started together with the line managers and an open internal announcement will be published on our intranet the first week of October. This process will include interest/nominations and we will also contact candidates directly.
 Head of School appoints prefects in discussion with KTH President.




