How it works

Our courses have a flexible study pace, this means that you yourself can decide upon what pace to study at. The enrollment of the course will take place after the course has started. In order to enroll to the course you need to have been accepted, created an RCN account as well as started the course. It is possible to begin the course in advance however your results will not be registered in our local grades database, LADOK, until the course has started.

Getting started

In order to start a course you need to create an online account, the so called RCN account. You create the account through the course website. To find your course please enter http://www.kth.se/rcn?l=en_UK and click on the subject heading of the course. Please make sure that the account and notification are for the same course date. Contact the student counselors at RCN if you need help.

Student Lounge is a platform where you as a student can access course material, exercises as well as some exams. Accepted to several course starts for the same course?

Have you applied to more than one course start for the same course at studera.nu? You can only be registered to one course occasion at the time. If it is important for you to be accepted at a certain course e.g. on account of CSN, please contact the student counselors. You will otherwise be enrolled at the next occasion that the course is taking place. If you have only applied to one course you do not need to contact the student counselors.

Are you going to apply for student funds?

As a student to one of RCNs courses you are eligible for a student loan and/or allowance, please note the weeks the course is taking place when applying for funding. Also keep in mind that the study pace you has set will affect your funding. If you need help obtaining the correct funding please contact CSN.
