

## How to categorize courses

There are three categories of third cycle courses at EES:

- General skills courses
- Basic courses
- Advanced courses

To see which category a certain course belongs to; look at the course code. It usually looks something like this: FEE3333

**F**EE3333

The F tells it's a third cycle course

**E**EE3333

The first E tells that this is Electrical Engineering

FE**E**3333

The second E is actually always another letter and tells which department the course belongs to

FEE**3**3333

The first 3 tells it's a third cycle course (as well as the F, which is why the F is sometimes left off, as it is redundant)

FEE3**3**333

The second digit (1, 2 or 3) tells what category the course belongs to

- 1: General skills
- 2: Basic
- 3: Advanced

FEE33**33**

The last digits are free digits with no inherent meaning – the department uses these to organize their courses
