would like to give you all a warm welcome back and I hope you have had an energizing holiday. Today, the autumn term starts for real and during the past two weeks, the reception of our new students has been going on. Many student as well as co-workers are deeply engaged in the welcoming of the new students and are making a fantastic effort. It is fun to see the enthusiasm during these weeks and we now hope that the new students are inspired to undertake their studies.

The past two weeks have also been intense in the startup of the autumn's work, where we have carried out a conference with the University board, US, on the theme "KTH's quality system for education" and a strategy day with CBH's management group to plan the activities for the coming year.

During the autumn, the Swedish higher education authority, UKÄ, will evaluate KTH's quality system for education by us having handed in a self-evaluation and through locality visits from a group of assessors.

The first visit is on October 1, when the group of assessors will meet KTH's management, dean of faculty, vice dean of faculty, GA and FA. Thereafter, the group of assessors will ask to meet representatives from the activities on November 26 and 27. As soon as we know who you are, we will contact you.

During the conference with US, we got to listen to the most important experiences from Mälardalen university and Dalarna university about everything from the self-evaluation work to the preparations for locality visits and the management of the results. Mälardalen university weren't approved, while Dalarna university have an approved quality system. It is the system for quality follow-up in education that is being examined and not, as last time, the quality in education, which then was carried out by examination of degree projects.

From our strategy day, we can report that we invited our contact lawyers at KTH avtal (avtal@kth.se): Björn Rudolfsson and Georg Stenström. As we have previously written in CBH News, we have clarified the process for agreement management at CBH and we want to further guarantee the process since it is strategically important for CBH since we have the absolutely largest external funding in KTH terms, where agreements become an important part.

We also discussed new faculty positions at CBH and will be able to announce around five new positions per year if our ambition is to keep the size of our faculty. Furthermore, we worked with concrete activities linked to our development plan and we will account for these at our large school meetings and in management groups etc.

I want to mention that our administration received praise today for working better and better at our school, which is not only big but also geographically dispersed. A big thank you to all co-workers in the administration, who make sure we are moving in the right direction.

Gaston Crespo has been awarded the 2019 Sensors Young Investigator Award.

The award is handed out by the scientific journal Sensors. <u>Gaston Crespo</u> is assistant professor at the division Applied Physical Chemistry at the CBH school.

We are pleased to announce that the winner of the 2019 *Sensors* Young Investigator Award is Dr. Gaston A. Crespo.

Dr. Gaston A. Crespo is an Associate Professor of the Department of Chemistry in CBH, KTH, Sweden. Crespo's research interests are in electroanalytical chemistry, membrane transport, new materials, development of electrochemical techniques, electrochemiluminescence and optical sensors for environmental and biomedical applications (POC and wearable sensors), photo-triggered devices, and synchrotron characterization Dr. Crespo received his Ph.D. degree in 2010 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 88 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and 2 international patents. Gaston's Scopus Scientific Citations is 2,034 and his Hirsch index is 25., and he is clearly a rising star in the field of electrochemical sensors. As a single applicant, Dr. Crespo has secured funding of more than 2 million EUR since 2017. This is an outstanding achievement in today's competitive environment. Please join us in congratulating Dr. Crespo for his outstanding achievements.


