n Monday last week, we had School dialogue 2 with the president and we presented two targeted efforts: starting grant for five faculty positions, all with the orientation sustainable development and suggestions for strategic effort at the CBH School, the Department of biomedical engineering and health systems.

The background to the latest effort is that today's healthcare is characterized by a fast technological development, in particular with regard to digital opportunities and their implications. Significant advances are made within imaging and simulation of the body, sensor registration of physiology, motion and strain, as well as altered healthcare production models through new informatics and logistics.

The Department of biomedical engineering and health systems, MTH, mainly located in Flemingsberg and with a minor part in Solna, is a development of the former School of technology and health. After a tough period for the school in 2012 – 2016 and the efforts in dealing with a big divergence of subjects between the groups, the research has now focused on three key themes:

- 1. Biomedical imaging and simulation
- 2. Sustainable working life
- 3. Digitalisation of healthcare and care

The department is characterised bybeing a natural site for collaboration between healthcare and technology. The research is based on basic technological research from other schools/departments at KTH and has the specific medical requirement specification as a basis. Contacts and cooperation with other departments within KTH have increased considerably since the school merger and the new profiling of MTH.

The strategic effort at MTH includes:

- "Start-up"-grant for eight positions (750 kSEK/position for four years) = 6 MSEK/year for four years. Year 2020 (4), year 2021 (4) (FoFu)

- Grant for "Makerspace" (1 MSEK/ year for four years) 2019- (GRU)

- Increase of faculty grants for MTH with five permanent positions (5 MSEK/year). 2 MSEK 2020, + 3 MSEK 2021 (FoFu)

With this strategic effort, MTH will be able to strengthen its research environment considerably and in November, we will learn how the president views our strategic efforts.

Sequencing of genes

LU has signed a framework agreement concerning different types of sequencing of isolated, individual genes, in particular so called Sanger sequencing, which KTH can order from. Providers in the new agreement are Macrogen and Eurofins Genomics Sweden AB, with effect from 2019-11-01.

Ordering is performed through renewed competition, contact the purchase and procurement manager on this matter.
